We will get to sit at a Senator's desk and learn about different laws and history.








We might also visit Senator Edward M. Kennedy's office.

Senator Kennedy was the Senator for Massachusetts for 47 years and helped found this Institute that we are visiting!










We might go into a studio classroom to learn more about a bill or law. Or we might do an activity related to our program.

When we are finished with the program, we might eat lunch at the Kennedy Institute!


A staff member will lead our group to one of the studio classrooms, or if the weather is nice, we might get to eat outside!
